CAPITAL BEGINS BIG DANCE AGAINST #23 CENTRE (Ky.) FRIDAY AT WOOSTER

Capital University plays in the NCAA Division III Men's Basketball Championship for the first time since 1996 when it plays Centre (Ky.) College in the first round at 6 p.m. Friday at The College of Wooster in Wooster, Ohio.

The other half of the regional features host Wooster against Transylvania (Ky.) University at 8 p.m. on Friday. The winners of both games play at 7 p.m. Saturday.

Capital (19-8) punched its ticket to the big dance winning the Ohio Athletic Conference Tournament title with a 78-73 win over John Carroll University. The Crusaders are making their ninth appearance in the NCAA Tournament but first since 1996.

Centre (23-4) got into the NCAA Tournament by winning the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference (SCAC) Tournament with a 72-57 win over Trinity (Texas). The Colonels are making their 10th NCAA Tournament appearance and first since 1992. Centre College is in Danville, Ky., which is 30 miles southwest of Lexington, Ky. and approximately a four-hour drive and 230 miles from Columbus.

HOW THEY GOT HERE ...

On January 20, Capital suffered a three-point loss at the buzzer to Baldwin-Wallace, 81-78 to find themselves at 9-7 overall on the season. Since then the Crusaders have gone 10-1 with lone loss coming in overtime, 73-69, at Otterbein in the regular season finale. Capital won a share of its ninth OAC regular season championship then claimed its third-ever OAC Tournament title.

Centre is having one of its best seasons in school history as the Colonels 23 wins so far this season is third-most in school history the 1988-89 (24-7) and 1978-79 (25-5) teams. Centre's turning point came in a 73-67 loss to DePauw (Ind.) in the conference opener. After that game, the Colonels have won 20 of their last 21 games, tied DePauw for the SCAC regular season championship then won the SCAC Tournament.

THE COACHES

Damon Goodwin (Dayton '86) is 201-138 (.593) in his 13th season as head coach at Capital. Goodwin has a pair of OAC regular season titles (2002-03, 2006-07), a OAC Tournament title (2007) and was named the OAC Coach of the Year in 1996 and 2007. This is his second NCAA appearance as Capital coach (1996, 2007). Prior to his days in Columbus, he spent five years as an assistant coach at Wittenberg University, where they went to the NCAA Tournament four times and made it to the national semifinals in 1994.

Greg Mason (Centre '94) is 142-67 (.679) in his eighth season as head coach at his Alma mater. Mason's teams have averaged almost 18 wins a season and have set 17 school and 11 conference team records. Mason spent a year as an assistant at Kentucky Wesleyan and three as an assistant at Centre before taking the helm.

SCOUTING THE COLONELS

Centre is one of the nation's top defensive teams ranking third in the nation in scoring defense at 57.5 points per game. In fact, the only games the Colonels have allowed more than 70 points a game was in each of their four losses.

Centre has eight players playing more than 13 minutes per game, but everything starts out front with junior guard Matt Nestheide. Nestheide is the SCAC Player of the Year and leads the Colonels in scoring (15.3 ppg), assists (88) and steals (29). Senior forward John Patterson, who leads the team in rebounding (7.6 rpg) and blocks (59) picked up SCAC Defensive Player of the Year honors, while freshman Danny Noll earned the SCAC Freshman of the Year award.

GOODWIN & STAHL HEADLINE ALL-OAC SELECTIONS

Capital head coach Damon Goodwin was named OAC Coach of the Year and sophomore wing Nate Stahl was named to the All-OAC First Team by the conference's head coaches. Goodwin also won the award in his second year at Capital in 1996, while Stahl, an honorable mention selection last year, was the only underclassman and first Crusader since Jake Beck in 2005 to be in the first team. Junior forward Steve Kyser and sophomore guard Ryan Wood were both All-OAC honorable mention selections.

NATE NO. 1

Sophomore Nate Stahl leads the nation in three-point shooting percentage at 51.1 percent (71-of-141). Stahl leads Capital in scoring (14.2 ppg) and is second in rebounding (4.5 rpg).

ALGE OAC TOURNAMENT MVP

Capital's lone senior, Brian Alge, was named the most valuable player of the OAC Tournament. Alge has played in a team-high 95 career games and is a two-time Academic All-OAC selection. If Alge wins the award again this year, he will join Mike Potts (1993-1995) as the only Capital players to be Academic All-OAC three times.

GOING DOWNTOWN

While Capital's campus is just five minutes east of downtown Columbus, the Crusaders have gone downtown often this season. Capital has a school single-season record of 180 made three-pointers this season. Sophomore Nate Stahl has 72 of those which leaves him only eight behind the 80 made by Brad Howe in the 1997-98 season.

BLOCK PARTY

This year's Capital team has tied the 1995-96 squad for the single-season school record for blocked shots with 107. Junior forward Ben Gunn has a school record 75 blocks this season and is the school's career leader with 96. Gunn is also eighth in the nation this season averaging 2.8 blocks per game.

POLL POSITION

Capital is receiving votes in this week's D3Hoops.com Top 25 poll. The Crusaders have received votes the last few weeks but have been unranked the entire season. Capital is 3-1 and have won three-straight games this season against ranked teams with lone loss coming in double overtime in the season opener against Wittenberg.

Centre is making its first-ever appearance in the D3Hoops.com Top 25 poll this week breaking in at No. 23. The Colonels have not played a nationally ranked team this season.

NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Capital is making its ninth NCAA Tournament appearance and the Crusaders have a 7-8 record in tournament games. From 1957 to 1989, the NCAA recognized regional champions in its tournament format and in 1982 Capital claimed the South Region championship before falling in the national quarterfinals. Centre is making its 10th NCAA Tournament appearance but first since 1992. The Colonels advanced to the national semifinals in 1979 and 1989.

AGAINST THE OTHER TWO TEAMS

Transylvania (Ky.) University and The College of Wooster are the other two teams in this regional bracket and Capital has played both of these teams before.

Capital and Transylvania have met three previous times with the Pioneers holding a 2-1 edge. Transylvania posted wins in 1976-77 (72-67) and 1979-80 (58-56), while Capital won the 1978-79 meeting (84-77). Capital scrimmaged at Transylvania this season.

Wooster was a member of the Ohio Athletic Conference from 1924-1984. Capital and Wooster have met 37 times with the Crusaders holding a 22-15 lead in the series. Since leaving the OAC, Capital and Wooster have met six times with Capital winning four of those games. The Crusaders have won their last two games at Timken Gymnasium in Wooster in 2001 and 2003.
