Widener's Coleman and King's Wilson Highlight 2001 *Football Gazette* All-South Region Team;

The team is selected by South Region Sports Information Directors for the 12th straight year

(ABILENE, TEXAS)----Wide Receiver **Michael Coleman (Wilmington, Del.)** of Widener (Pa.) University, defensive lineman **Steven Wilson (Yardley, Pa.)** of King's (Pa.) College were named 2001 Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in the *Football Gazette* South Region as voted on by a panel of sports information directors from the region. Punter **Scott Verhalen (Marchall, Texas)** of East Texas Baptist Univeristy was named Special Teams Player of the Year and Bridgewater College head coach Mike Clark was named Coach of the Year in the region. A total of 75 players were chosen for the *Football Gazette* All-South Region team from a pool of 152 nominations. It is selected by sports information directors from the 63 schools that sponsor football in the South Region. This year marks the 12th straight year that the region's sports information directors have selected an All-South Region team. The All-South Region first and second team selections will now be on a national ballot used to choose the 2001 *Football Gazette* All-American Team.

Coleman, a senior, had 55 catches for 1,201 yards and 15 catches to lead Widener to the NCAA South Region Final. He was named co-Most Valuable Player of the Middle Atlantic Conferences. **Wilson** was a first team All-MAC selection as the junior tallied 73 tackles with 38.5 of those for a loss along with 19.5 sacks as he helped lead King's to a ECAC Southeast Region Championship. **Verhalen** averaged 43.7 yards per punt as as a sophomore on his way to first team All-American Southwest Conference honors.

Clark led Bridgewater to its best season in school history going undefeated and winning the Old Dominion Athletic Conference title. The ODAC Co-Coach of the Year has the Eagles in the NCAA South Region Championship game.
